USE OF WACIC/NCIC CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION AND DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR LICENSING RECORD INFORMATION

As a visitor of King County Sheriff's Office Communications Center, you may have access to confidential criminal records, Department of Licensing records, or other criminal justice information, much of which is controlled by statute. All access to Washington Crime Information Center (WACIC) and National Crime Information Center (NCIC) related information is based on the "need to know" and the "right to know" and is overseen by the Washington State Patrol (WSP) ACCESS section. Misuse of such information may adversely affect an individual's civil rights, and violates the law and/or WACIC/NCIC policy.
