Legislature cuts revenues to cities to balance budget

- In order to adopt a balanced state budget, the Legislature cut the amount of liquor taxes shared with cities by half.
- Shoreline will lose an average of \$135,000 a year for the next five years, with a cumulative loss of nearly one million dollars by 2020.
