Terms shall expire on the thirty-first day of March, except youth member terms shall begin on September 1 and expire on June 30 unless the youth member is appointed to an additional term. No parks board member shall serve more than three consecutive four-year terms, and youth members shall serve no more than two consecutive one-year terms.
