Jesse –

You are correct in assuming the red line on item 7(c) attachment A is for the design services of the 195th Separated Trail project. As noted in the staff report, the consultant was selected as part of a formal Request for Qualifications (RFQ) and the cost for services was negotiated as part of the process; all of which is within the City's purchasing policies. The cost of services was evaluated and is within expected values based upon the staff's experience.

It is staff's preference for the work to be designed within the department, in part to control costs and to be more effective with the use of resources. However, limited staffing requires the City to hire consultants at this time for this particular project.
