Background

- Shoreline School District Adopted Resolution No. 2013-17 (Ballot Proposition No. 1) authorizing a four-year replacement tax levy for educational programs, maintenance and operations
- The Levy will fund basic education programs not fully supported by state and federal funding, including special education programs, highly capable programs, vocational programs, nurses, librarians, and maintenance of current class size, among other uses
- Proposition No. 1 will be submitted to the voters for the February 11, 2014 special election
- Proposed Council Resolution No. 354 would declare support for School District Proposition No. 1



Public Hearing

- City can take a position on a ballot issue as long as:
 - Title and ballot proposition number are included in the notice
 - Both proponents and opponents of the ballot proposition are provided an equal opportunity to provide comment
- Tonight's public hearing provides this opportunity



Recommendation

- The Levy will fund student computers and technology access, software and online resources, and technology staffing and training
- Proposition No. 2 will be submitted to the voters for the February 11, 2014 special election
- Proposed Council Resolution No. 354 would declare support for School District Proposition No. 2
