

Proposed Amendment #1

SMC 9.10.285

D. Notice of SODA Order

A person is deemed to have notice of the SODA order when:

- 1. The signature of the person prohibited in the order is affixed to the bottom of the order, acknowledging receipt of the order; or
- The order otherwise indicates that either the person or the person's attorney received a copy of the order appeared before the court at the time the order was entered.
- Staff recommends that this amendment be adopted

Proposed Amendment #2

SMC 9.10.285

F. Penalties.

- 1. <u>Pre-Trial SODA Order</u>: Any person who knowingly disobeys a SODA order <u>entered as a condition of pre-trial release</u> shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor found in contempt of court.
- 2. <u>Post-Sentencing SODA Order:</u> Any person who knowingly disobeys a SODA order <u>entered as a condition of sentencing may also be found in contempt of court shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.</u>
- Staff does not recommend adoption of this amendment

Recommendation

 Staff recommends that Council adopt proposed Ordinance No. 688 establishing designated SODA areas and establishing regulations for the enforcement of these areas.
