2015 Legislative Preview

- McLeary Decision adds estimated \$1.2 to \$2.0 Billion in budget gap
- State shared revenue and revenue that is available to cities at risk
- Transportation package highly unlikely



2015 Legislature

- 2015 – 2017 Biennial budget year
- 120-day or long legislative session
- Control of Senate still unknown
- Difficult decisions to make could cause session to go into overtime

- Funding for 145th St. Corridor Project
- Preserve City Utility Authority
- Clarify Marijuana system rules
