Public Process

- Common themes from Open House & Website
 - Foster economic development (especially good restaurants / small businesses)
 - Maintain services (increase public safety)
 - Infrastructure improvements (roads, sidewalks)
 - Support MFR (high traffic and light rail corridors)
 - General support for 10YFSP and the process
 - Look at agreements with the school district
 - Lots of great questions (public seeking information)

10-Year Financial Sustainability Targets

- Economic Development 160 mfr + 7,500 sq ft retail
- Expenditure Growth 0.2% less
- Investment Returns 1.0% more
- Cost Recovery 2015 study, 2016 implementation
- Interfund Transfer New source for \$290K
- B&O Tax 2016 business engagement
- Property Tax Levy Lid Lift 2016 community engagement

Proposed Amendment

- Target #6:
 - "In 2016 or later, engage the business community in a discussion regarding the possible future implementation of a Business and Occupation (B&O) Tax, to include a threshold exemption on a certain amount of gross receipts."
