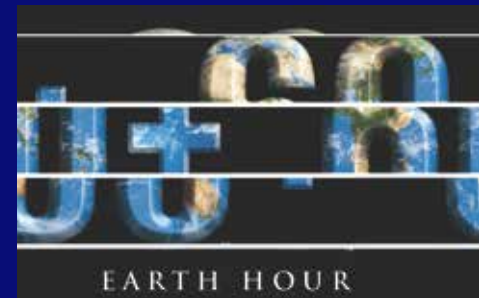
Earth Hour
