#### EMC hold time amendment

### Pylon sign number amendment

I move to amend Section 20.50.620.E.8 of Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 712 by changing the maximum number of allowed pylon signs from three (3) to four (4) pylon signs with one (1) sign allowed on the N 160th Street CRA Lifestyle Frontage, one (1) sign allowed on the Westminster Way N CRA Lifestyle Frontage, and two (2) signs allowed on the Aurora Avenue N CRA Lifestyle Frontage.



#### Pylon sign location amendment

I move to amend Section 20.50.620.E.8 of Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 712 by adding a provision in regards to CRA Pylon Signs that limits their location to area on the CRA Lifestyle Frontages that are directly across from properties with Mixed Business (MB) zoning.
