Debbie,

I saw the budget proposal for vegetation management regulations.

As you know, Shoreline has looked at vegetation management regulations several times to address large tracts of land. It has, at times, been very controversial. I was on the planning commission in 2005 when a proposal was under consideration. I was willing to support it then, and could now, if and only if (1) it includes meaningful monitoring and enforcement provisions, including a broad grant of permission for city staff to access the site for the purpose of compliance monitoring, and (2) the standard for protection of critical area functions and values is at least as good as it is in our critical area regulations.
