Background

- Council discussed proposed 2016-2018 Goals at Strategic Planning Workshop
- Continued focus towards achievement of Vision 2029 and being a sustainable city in all respects
- Council determined that four of the five 2015-2017 goals are still relevant and supportive of Vision 2029
- Exception to this is a change to Council Goal #4 – amended focus on equity and inclusion
- Other amendments to the Action Steps for the Goals

Proposed Council Goals

- **Goal 1:** Strengthen Shoreline's economic base to maintain the public services that the community expects
- **Goal 2:** Improve Shoreline's utility, transportation, and environmental infrastructure
- **Goal 3:** Prepare for two Shoreline light rail stations
- **Goal 4:** Expand the City's focus on equity and inclusion to enhance opportunities for community engagement
- **Goal 5:** Promote and enhance the City's safe community and neighborhood programs and initiatives
