This afternoon we received a request from Councilmember Salomon to include phasing of the preferred alternative. Below is his proposed amendment language. We have included a hand-done map of what the amendment would look like on the Planning Commission recommendation — Compact Community Hybrid.

Proposed Amendment:

I move to include phasing on the preferred alternative by superimposing the phasing map from the connecting corridors reviewed by the Planning Commission onto the preferred alternative. Areas not included in the preferred alternative for rezoning would be excluded. Phase 1 would be effective when the zoning is adopted as part of the subarea plan (2016) and Phase 2 would be effective in 2033.
