# Discussion of Ordinance 747 – Amending Chapter 13.14 (Solid Waste) of the Shoreline Municipal Code



#### Background

 Council approved 2017 – 2027 Solid Waste Contract with single-family residential mandatory solid waste collection on May 2, 2016

 Chapter 13.14 of the Shoreline Municipal Code does not currently address mandatory solid waste collection



### **New Mandatory Code Definition**

"Residential Property" means a single-family dwelling, a mobile home, or a multi-family residence containing no more than four dwelling units on a public or private road.





### Evaluative Criteria for Exemptions

Common situations

Occasional self-hauling

No new civil penalties

## Sample Exemptions from other Cities

Bonney Lake	Kent	Covington
Physical inaccessibility	No waste generated	<ul> <li>Similar exemptions as Bonney Lake and Kent plus</li> </ul>
Customer disability	<ul> <li>Use of commercial account by resident owning business</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Adjacent properties sharing an account</li> </ul>



### Situational Exemptions

Temporary vacancy of residence

 Continued ability to transport solid waste to a King County disposal facility outside of the regular pick up cycle



### (New) Section 13.14.035 Mandatory Collection – Residential Property

Every person in possession, charge, or control of residential property will be charged for at least the minimum level of solid waste service whether the person uses the service or not, unless an exception applies.





## (New) Section 13.14.035 Mandatory Collection – Residential Property Exception A.

A residential property customer may temporarily suspend solid waste service due to vacations or other reasons in one week increments for an indefinite period of time and may be charged a standby fee if the suspension is greater than two weeks.



## (New) Section 13.14.035 Mandatory Collection – Residential Property Exception B.


Residential customers may, on an occasional and limited basis, haul solid waste, recyclable materials, or yard debris to an approved King County collection site. However, the residential property customer must continue to participate in and pay for the mandatory solid waste collection service.



### Legal Authority

 The State Constitution and statutes allow the City to enact regulations that Council determines are necessary and appropriate for public health, safety and general community well-being.

 Council affirmed that mandatory collection would decrease vermin, odors and litter, and increase public & environmental health and recycling.
