I'm reading for the first time the Sound Transit motion regarding restrooms. I see that it dates back to 1998. It seems to me that back in 1998 the Sound Transit board might not have recognized the potential for the station at 145th Street to be a regional multimodal station such as the ones identified at Northgate, Bellevue, or Everett. Rather than requiring restrooms at both of our stations, I would prefer an approach where we work with Sound Transit staff and board members to update their policy from 1998 to recognize the regional significance of the 145th station as a multi-modal station and to add it to the list where they intend to provide restrooms. 145th is where we have the multi-modal connection to bus rapid transit.
