We are excited about the light rail, growth and the future of our city. We have lived in Shoreline for 20 years and are parents of an adult with a developmental disability who graduated from Shorewood HS and attends the Shoreline Specialized Recreation programs. He has lived here for most of his life and like most other Shoreline residents, loves his community. Our care provider, Jill Rogers lives close to where the 145th street station is located which opens many opportunities for our children to be a part of this growth. Her plan is to continue providing respite care for many Shoreline families but to also add a housing unit for several folks with disabilities the opportunity of affordable housing (Section 8) with staff support.

Please include 15824 5th Ave NE in the MUR-35 rezone for affordable and accessible housing for people with developmental disabilities. Instead of stopping at 158th, expand to 160th which is the end of the block or farther- even if it's just the east side of 5th Ave NE. Our adult children want the chance to stay in Shoreline- and the housing options for this population are sadly <u>few</u> and far between. We desperately need affordable and accessible housing options in Shoreline!
