Please include 15824 5th Ave NE in the MUR-35 rezone for affordable and accessible housing for people with developmental disabilities. Instead of stopping at 158th, expand to 160th which is the end of the block or farther- even if it's just the east side of 5th Ave NE. Our adult children want the chance to stay in Shoreline - and the housing options for this population are sadly few and far between. We desperately need affordable and accessible housing options in Shoreline!
