RE 145th Subarea rezone

We are extremely disappointed with the council's rezone of our neighborhood, upper Pelican Park. How and why did you come up with this mess of a rezone?

You kept Lower Pelican Park R-6 but not Upper Pelican Park. WHY? The Upper Pelican Park circle is only 1/5<sup>th</sup> of a mile around. There is only one access in or out. We understand that R-6 has a 35' limit, as does MUR 35. We can live with that. However, this neighborhood cannot support businesses that will increase traffic and require parking.

The resolution of the map on the council's website is so low you can't tell which parcel is R-6 and which is MUR 35 when they are side by side. Evidently, the council has changed 17 of the 29 properties to MUR-35. It is ridiculous to have this varied zoning in this small area.

I do not know how many of you have walked the neighborhood, but we were pleased that at least 2 of you did, and you had the courtesy to speak with some of the neighbors, including me.

I was a big supporter of the levy vote that will be on the November ballot. Because of this I will vote NO. And most of my neighbors will vote no also. You have let us down; we don't trust you to act in the best interest of the people who live here; we don't trust you to spend our money wisely.
