

Resolution No. 397 Declaring Support for
Shoreline School District Ballot Proposition
No. 1 –
Bonds to Rebuild School and
Build and Early Learning Center

December 5, 2016



Background

- Shoreline School Board unanimously placed a bond proposition on the February special election ballot.
- Proposition No. 1 seeks to enhance the learning environment and relieve overcrowding by rebuilding Kellogg Middle School, Einstein Middle School and Parkwood Elementary School and building an Early Learning Center at the current Children's Center site.
- Proposition No. 1 would issue no more than \$250,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 20 years and levy annual excess property taxes to repay the bonds.
- Council heard a factual presentation from the Shoreline School District Superintendent regarding Proposition No. 1 on November 21.



Proposed Resolution No. 397

- Provides Council Support for Shoreline School District Ballot Proposition No. 1
- If adopted, staff will share Resolution No. 397 with School District Board and staff



Public Comment on Proposed Resolution

- City can take a position on a ballot issue as long as:
 - Title and ballot proposition number are included in the notice
 - Both proponents and opponents of the ballot proposition are provided an equal opportunity to provide comment
- As this is a proposed Action Item in front of the Council for the first time, public comment on this resolution shall follow the staff report but precede Council review



Recommendation
