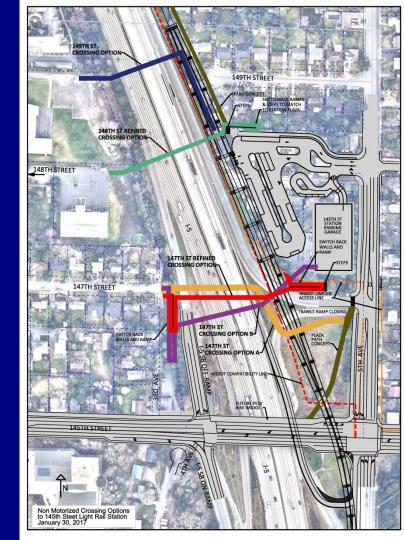

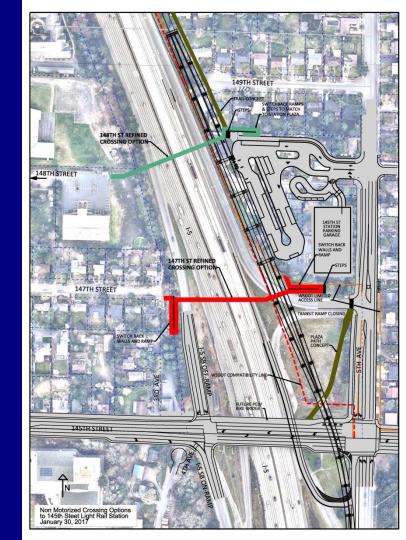

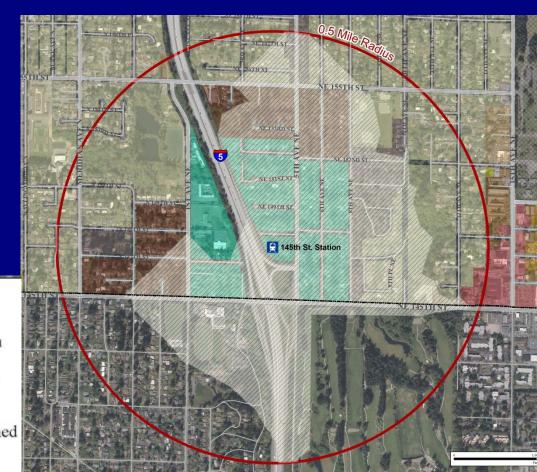


Baseline Walkshed

- Modest increase to walkshed
- Approx. 3.5 min. walk



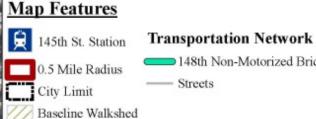
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148th Street Refined Crossing Option

- Greatest increase to walkshed
- Approx. 2.4 min. walk

Preferred Alternative Recommendation

Refined 148th Street Crossing Option

- Lowest cost option
- Shortest crossing distance
- Greatest increase to walkshed

2017 Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) budget includes \$500,000 for 147th/148th Street Non-motorized Bridge – 30% Design and Environmental Analysis
