Shoreline Clinic: A Community Partner

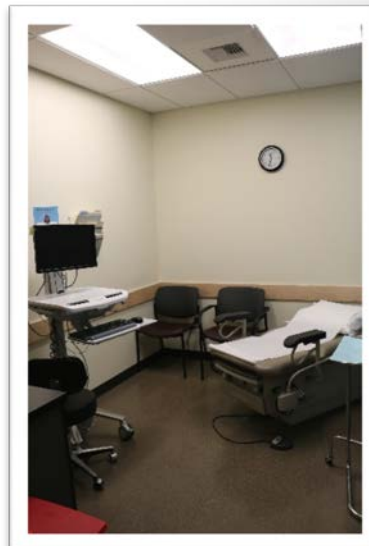
Opened September 2014

- First community clinic in Shoreline
- Revitalization of Aurora Ave corridor
- Health care expansion under Affordable Care Act
- Regional growth Asian Pacific Islander, immigrant and underserved populations

Who We Keep Healthy



- Over 5,139 patients by end of 2016
- 15% 65 years and over
- 9% children, infants to 9 years
- 70% persons of color
- Top languages: English, Korean, Cantonese, Mandarin, Vietnamese
- 54% below 100% of the federal poverty level
- 23% between 101% to 200% of federal poverty level
- 4% homeless
- 11% uninsured

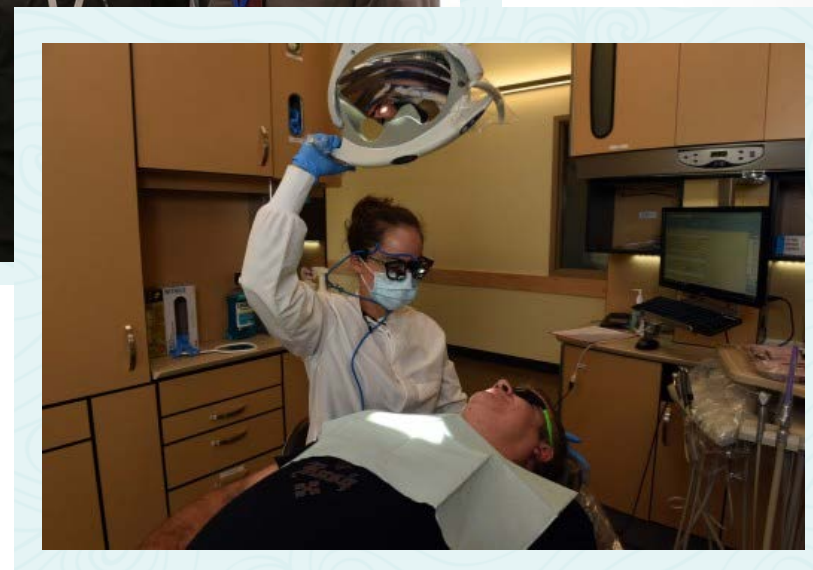


Strengthening Shoreline's Health

Dental Residency Program

Started : July 2015

- With NYU-Lutheran Medical Center Dental Medicine Advanced Education in General Dentistry Residency Program
- Dental residents train to provide primary dental care to ICHS patients
- ICHS hosts two dentists

Women, Infant, Children Program (WIC)

Opened : [March 2016](#)

- Caseload is 150, currently 62 enrolled
- Food vouchers for supplemental nutritious foods
- Nutrition assessment and education
- Breastfeeding education
- Screenings and referrals to other health and social services

Young Adult Clinic (YAC)

Opened : [September 2016](#)

- Focused on young adults, ages 14-26
- Behavioral health counseling
- Pregnancy testing & counseling
- STD screening & treatment
- Reproductive health and contraception counseling and education

Strengthening Shoreline's Health

Pharmacy

Opened : February 2017

- Conveniently located in-house
- Discounted medications to low-income patients with no prescription coverage
- Accepts majority of private and Medicare Part D insurance plans
- Works with medical staff to provide coordinated clinical support
- Available for consultations
