Interurban / Burke Gilman Trail Connectors NE 155th Street | SHORELINE



Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements are coming to your street!

In 2013 City of Shoreline employees secured grant funding to construct two east-west connections between the Interurban and Burke Gilman Trails. City staff worked with Lake Forest Park to layout a northern route and a southern route (see attached map).

What is happening on NE 155th St?

The southern route is on NE 155th St from Aurora Ave N to 15th Ave NE. The project will install continuous bike lanes along the corridor. This will be accomplished by installing new markings between 5th Ave NE and 15th Ave NE similar to the ones west of 5th Ave NE. New roadway cross-section will include:

- 1) A 5.5' wide bike lane in each direction
- 2) A 10' wide vehicle lane in each direction
- 3) A 10' wide center turn lane

What will construction look like?

Construction impacts include, but are not limited to:

- Temporary loss of two-way traffic (all lane closures to be completed between the hours of 9am-3pm)
- Permanent loss of on-street parking along NE 155th St between 5th Ave NE and 15th Ave NE
- Temporary bus stop impacts

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in May. Work on NE 155th St should last 1-2 weeks, depending on weather.
