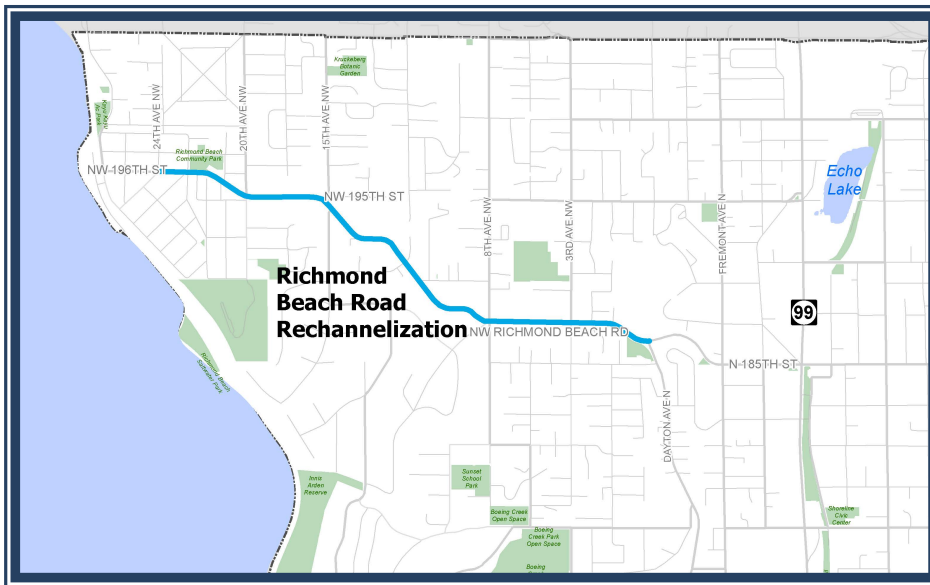


RICHMOND BEACH ROAD RECHANNELIZATION - PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE



The Richmond Beach Road corridor is an important east west connection serving Shoreline residents in the NW quadrant of the City. The primary goal of the project is to improve safety and mobility for all corridor users including people driving, walking, and biking.

The project will rechannelize Richmond Beach Rd/ NW 195th St/ NW 196th St from Dayton Ave N to 24th Ave NW from two lanes in each direction to one vehicle lane in each direction, bike lanes, and a center turn lane. The rechannelization provides the ability to implement on-street bike lanes, add pedestrian refuge space for people crossing the street, and helps mitigate the vehicle collision patterns seen along the corridor.



The City will be holding the first public meeting for the Richmond Beach Road Rechannelization project.
