The PCD Department, including the Permit Center, will open for business in their new location on Tuesday, Oct. 10.

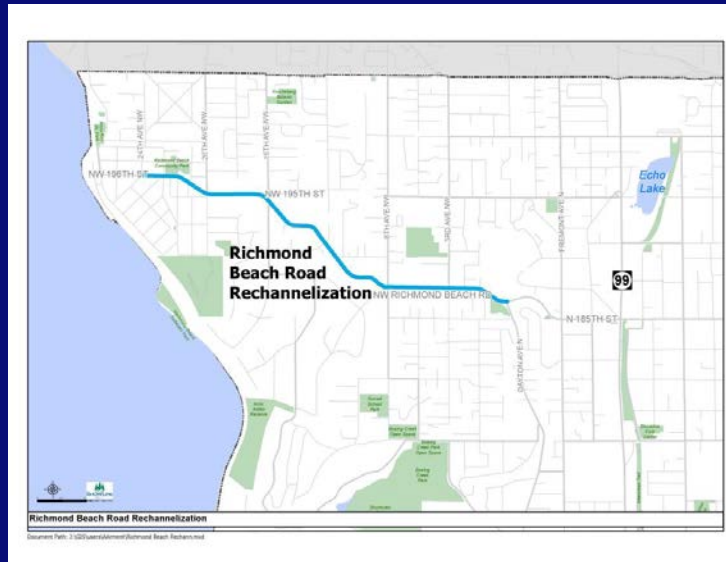
Monster Mash Dash 5K
