Thank you for your recent participation and comments regarding the City's Maintenance Facility Project. Over the last few months, many residents and interested parties provided comments and I wanted to send you an update on the Project.

On October 9, 2017, the City Council passed a motion to clarify that the maintenance facility analysis should **not** consider a combined maintenance facility site at Hamlin Park. Over the next several months, staff will be further analyzing potential improvements to meet the City's long-term maintenance facility needs using a combination of sites. Staff anticipates bringing initial recommendations to the City Council in the spring of 2018, with a final preferred option in late summer.
