SHORELINE POOL AND SPARTAN RECREATION CENTER

- POOL (15,375 sq. ft.)
 - With parking along 1st is 1.1 acres
 - Approximately 50 parking spaces
 - o 6-lane, 25 yard pool
 - Observation deck
- SPARTAN RECREATION CENTER (25,000 sq. ft.)
 - Including shared parking is 2.8 acres
 - Approximately 120 parking spaces
 - Double gym
 - Weight room
 - Multi-purpose activity rooms

- ► 1971: Shoreline Pool Constructed with Forward Thrust Bonds
- ▶ 1997: Transferred to City of Shoreline
- ▶ 1999: Master Plan Completed
- ▶ 2001: Improvements Completed

Build a Community/ Aquatics Center


Place a proposal for a new community/aquatics center before the voters by 2020. Open a new facility in 2022.



Where to locate

Evaluation Criteria

Criteria	Description
1. Central Location within Shoreline	Access to the greatest number of citizens?
2. City Development Goals	Anchor for Town Center, CRA at Shoreline Place, Along Aurora or within Light Rail Station Subareas?
3. Frequent Transit Opportunities	Are frequent transit connections available?
4. Vehicle Accessibility	Proximity to transit systems, I-5, Highway 99, main arterials?
5. Pedestrian and Bike Accessibility	Proximity to pedestrian and bike facilities?
6. Visibility	Easily seen and easy to access?
7. Ease of Land Assembly	Is it easy to assemble & acquire property?
8. Ownership	Is the property owned by the City? Another public agency or private property?

- frequent transit service






