Amendment No. 2: Interurban Trail Memorandum of Agreement (MOA)

Amendment with Seattle City Light

Amendment No. 2 for the Memorandum of Agreement for the Interurban Trail is attached for your signature.

This is Amendment No. 2 of the Shoreline Interurban Trail Memorandum of Agreement between the City of Seattle, through its City Light Department, and the City of Shoreline (City of Shoreline original contract number, 1542).

This addendum redefines the terms of the commencement of the 25-year MOA. A Specific Construction Term will commence upon execution of this amendment and expire upon completion of the trail (but no later than December 31, 2007). At this point, a Specific Use Term will commence and continue for an additional period of 25 years.

AMENDMENT #2 TO SHORELINE INTERURBAN TRAIL MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

Whereas an agreement was entered into by and between the City of Shoreline, Washington ("Shoreline"), and City of Seattle, City Light Department ("City Light") on August 9, 2001; and

Whereas said agreement was further modified by amendment April 30, 2003; and

Whereas the parties desire to further amend said agreement in order to reflect a change in term to comply with funding requirements for construction of the Interurban Trail by the City of Shoreline;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Existing Agreement Amended: The City of Shoreline and City Light entered into the agreement which is identified as: Shoreline Interurban Trail Memorandum of Agreement. The parties hereby amend that agreement.
- 2. Amendment to Existing Agreement: The agreement is amended in the following respect(s):
 - a.) The Term of Agreement, page 2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with new language as follows:

The Term of this Agreement shall commence upon execution, except that a Specific Construction Term will commence upon execution and extend until completion of the Trail in the Right of Way within Shoreline, but no later than December 31, 2007; and a Specific Use Term will commence from the end of the Specific Construction Term and continue for an additional period of twenty-five (25) years. Shoreline will give notice of the date of completion of the Trail (the end of the Specific Construction Term) to City Light. This Agreement shall terminate at the end of the Specific Use Term unless cancelled or renewed by the parties pursuant to the terms of this Memorandum of Agreement.

3. Remaining Terms and Conditions of Existing Agreement to Continue: The parties agree that, except as specifically provided in this amendment, the terms and conditions of the existing agreement continue in full force and effect.
