Dear Sirs:

The City of Shoreline is requesting the transfer of grant funds to WSDOT for the above noted project. In June of 1997 the City of Shoreline executed an agreement with WSDOT to utilize grant funds to construct a stormwater control project at Ronald Bog Park, adjacent to SR 5. Since that time, WSDOT has been preparing construction documents to provide left turn improvements at NE 175th St. and SR 5.

Water quality facilities will also be constructed as part of this project and the City of Shoreline recognizes these improvements meet the intent of the original City project for which the grant funds were received. Therefore, we request the grant funds (\$37,195 Federal and \$2,150 State) be transferred to WSDOT with the understanding that WSDOT will need to provide the local matching funds.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this _______ day of ______, 19_____, between the STATE OF WASHINGTON, Department of Transportation, acting by and through the Secretary of Transportation, hereinafter called the "STATE", and City of Shoreline, 17544 Midvale Ave N, Shoreline, Washington, 98133-0710, hereinafter called the "CITY";

WHEREAS, the STATE has obtained grant monies for Stormwater Control and has subsequently redistributed the grant monies to local agencies, and

WHEREAS, the CITY is planning to utilize the grant monies for construction of improvements under a project entitled "SR 5 - Stormwater Control - Ronald Bog Park", hereinafter called the "PROJECT", and

WHEREAS, the STATE will contribute 50% of the required matching funds, up to but not to exceed \$ 2,150 toward the CITY's PROJECT, and

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of RCW 47.28.140 and in consideration of the terms, conditions, covenants, and performances contained herein, or attached hereto and incorporated and made a part hereof, IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

I GENERAL

The CITY will act as lead agent in the construction of the PROJECT.

II PAYMENT

The STATE, in consideration of the faithful performance of the work to be done by the CITY, agrees to reimburse the CITY for the actual direct and related indirect cost of the work. An estimate of cost for work to be performed by the CITY at the STATE's expense is marked Exhibit "A", and is attached hereto and by this reference made apart of this AGREEMENT.

Partial payments shall be made by the STATE, upon request to the CITY, to cover costs incurred. These payments are not to be more frequent than one (1) per month. It is agreed that any such partial payment will not constitute agreement as to the appropriateness of any item and that, at the time of final audit, all required adjustments will be made and reflected in a final payment

The CITY agrees to submit a final bill to the STATE within forty-five (45) days after the CITY has completed the work.

III RIGHT OF ENTRY

The STATE hereby grants and conveys to the CITY the right of entry upon all land which the STATE has interest, within or adjacent to the right of way to the highway, for the purpose of designing the CITY's PROJECT.

Upon completion of the work outlined herein, all future operation and maintenance of the STATE's facilities shall be at the sole cost of the STATE and without expense to the CITY.

IV LEGAL RELATIONS

No liability shall attach to the CITY or the STATE by reason of entering into this agreement except as expressly provided herein.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this agreement as of the day and year first above written.
