Memorandum of Understanding Between the City of Shoreline Police Department and The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office For emergency police service to the unincorporated area of Snohomish County called Pt. Wells

ORIGINAL

Intent:

The intent of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to define protocols under which the Shoreline Police Department (SPD) will provide emergency first responder services to the Point Wells Chevron Plant, located in the unincorporated area of Snohomish County.

Conditions of Consent:

The Snohomish County Sheriff's Office (SCSO) retains jurisdiction over this unincorporated island and in no way relinquishes the duties and responsibilities to providing service to this area. However, there may be an occasion where an emergency arises at Point Wells and the response time for Snohomish County, because of inadequate access routes, would be detrimental to public safety. Therefore, under Washington Mutual Aid Peace Officers Powers Act, RCW 10.93, the Shoreline Police Department, a contracted police department of the King County Sheriff's Office, will provide emergency response when needed.

Emergency response will be limited to King County Sheriff's Communications Center Priorities X, 1 and 2 calls for service and their corresponding SNOPAC Priorities E, 1 and 2 calls for service. Once the initial response is completed, SPD will turn over the incident to SCSO. This may be in the form of an initial case report, entitled "Assist Other Agency", or by CAD message. SCSO will conduct all follow up investigations. To the degree necessary, SPD will assist SCSO as requested for follow up investigations and/or on scene support. In the case of a protracted event or unusual occurrence, the Shoreline Police Department will provide initial support and then turn the operation over to the SCSO. Such requests will be consistent with Mutual Aid protocols.

Enhanced 911 Service:

Calls from the Chevron Product Services Plant at Point Wells will be routed to the King County Enhanced 911 system. Priority X, 1 and 2 calls for service will be dispatched to the Shoreline Police Department. The CAD detail will be forwarded to SCSO via SnoPac for general broadcast to SCSO. Priority 3 and 4 details will be forwarded to SnoPac for dispatching.

Duration:

This agreement shall commence upon the date it is executed by both parties and continue during the tenure of the law enforcement officials executing same, unless either withdraws from this agreement upon seven (7) days written notice to the other.
