Ordinance No. 853 Authorization to Issue a Series of Bonds Supported by Shoreline Transportation Benefit District 0.2% Sales Tax Rate Increase



 Commits future City Councils to issue the debt as is required by law to ensure that all revenue generated by the tax supports the repayment of debt



- Authorizes issuance of a series of Limited Tax General Obligation bonds (Bonds)
 - Repaid by the revenue generated by the 0.2%
 Sales Tax.
 - Principal amount limited to \$42 million
 - The amount staff estimates could be supported by the estimated \$59 million in revenue.

- Details for each series determined at time of issue
- Presented to City Council for approval through a "Sales Resolution"



- Authorizes the creation of one or more Debt Service Funds
- Irrevocably pledges the 0.2% Sales Tax to the repayment of debt



Impact of I-976 (\$30 Car Tabs)

- Statewide Impact if Approved (\$242M) in 2020
- Shoreline Impact 2020:
 - \$20 VLF currently supporting Annual Road Surface
 Maintenance program (\$830K) per year
 - \$20 VLF effective in April for Sidewalk Rehabilitation program – (\$830K) per year
- No Impact to TBD Voted Sales Tax Anticipated
