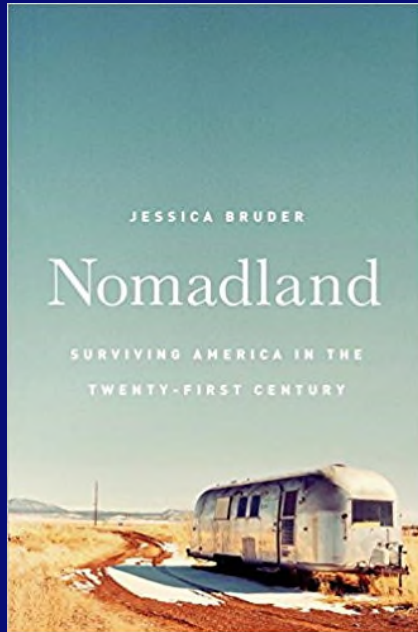
The team made up of Catholic Housing Services and Community Psychiatric Clinic will provide an update on the affordable housing project planned at 198th and Aurora.
