

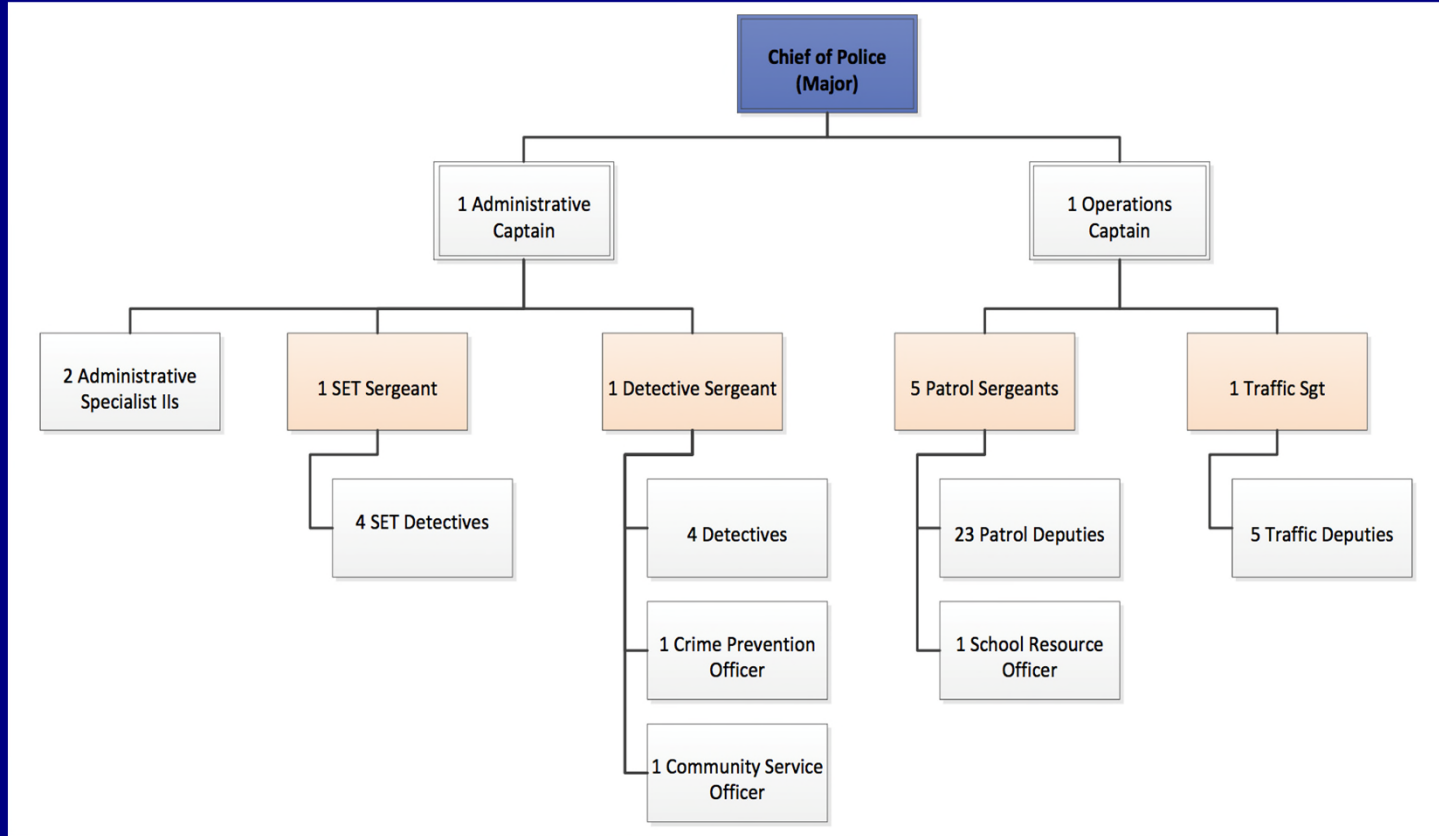

Organizational Chart

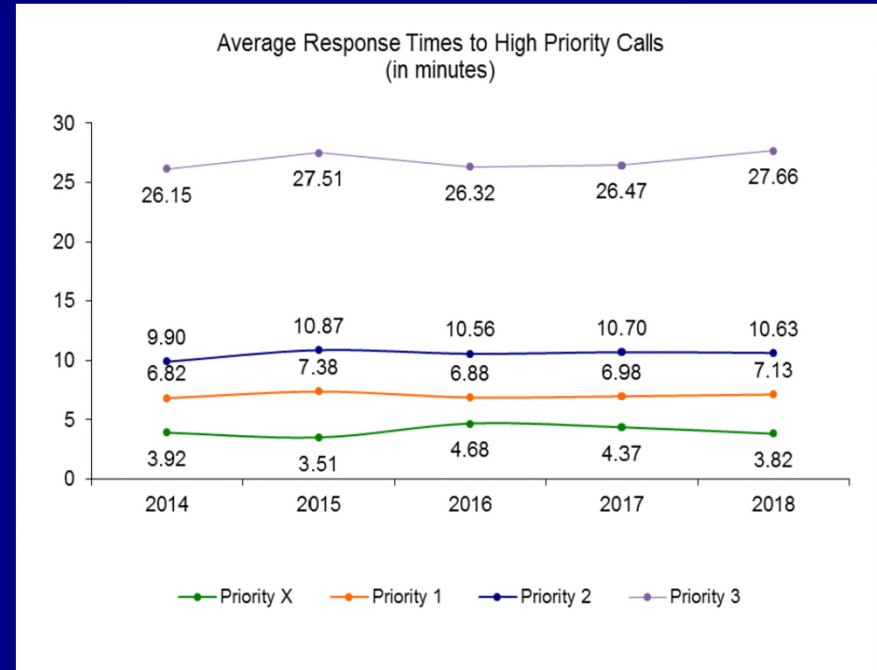
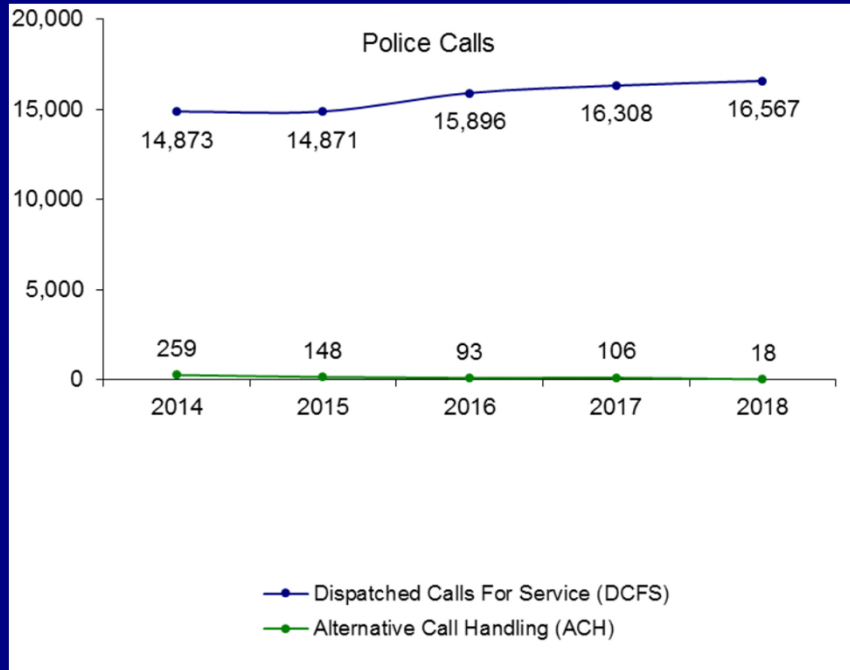

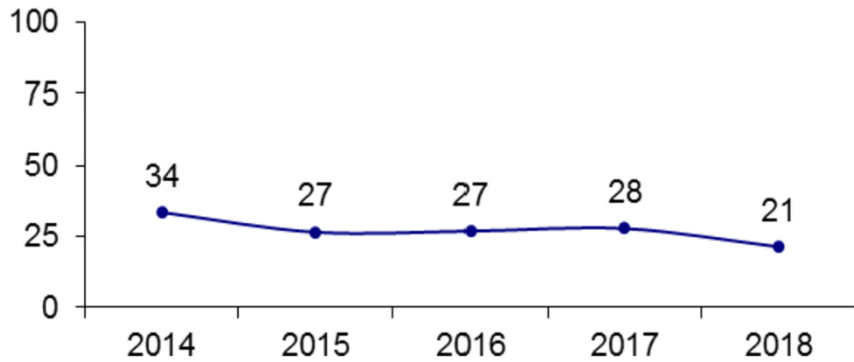

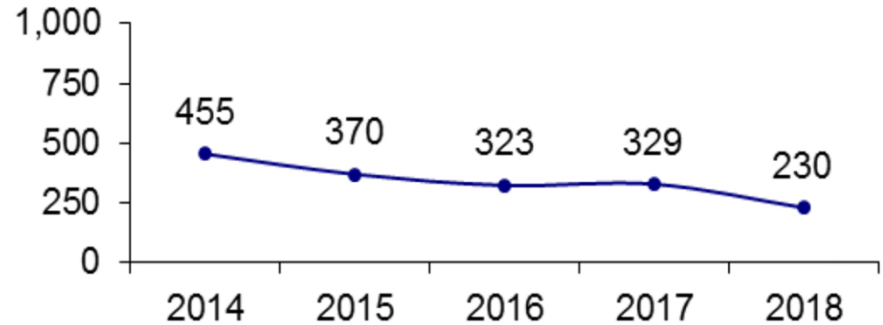

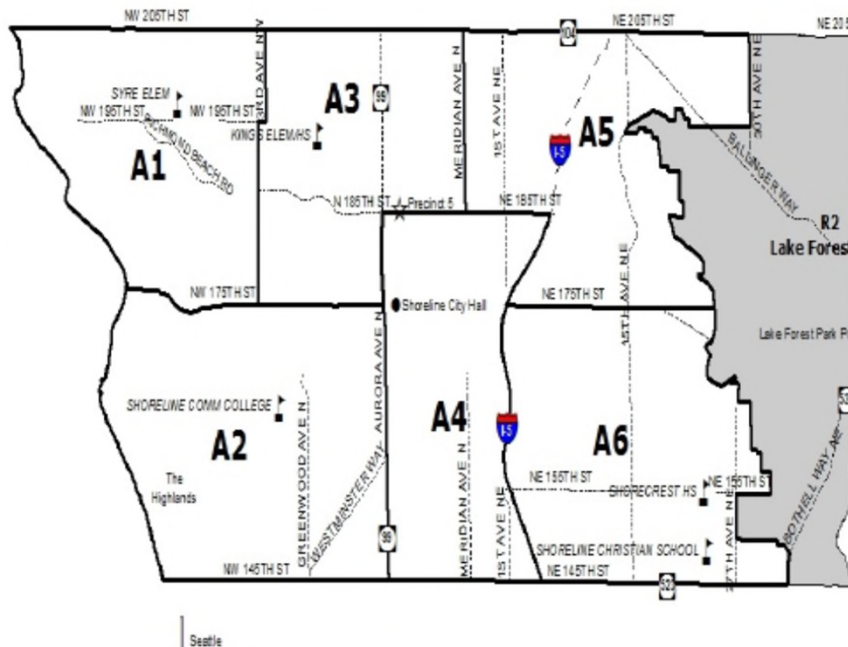
Part I Crimes Per 1,000 Residents



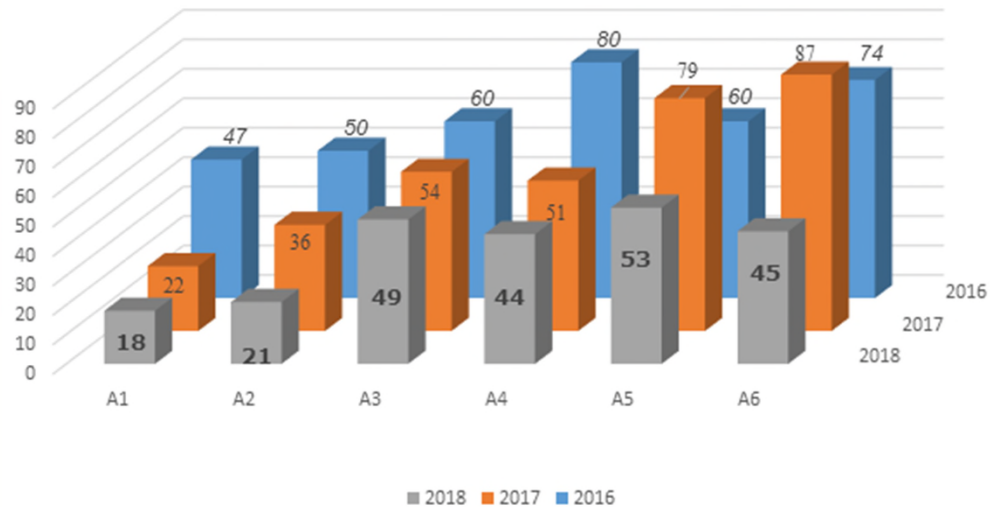

Burglaries by Patrol District

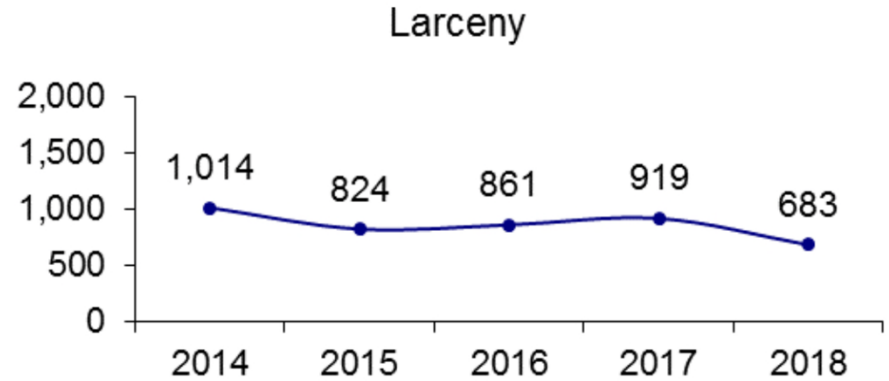
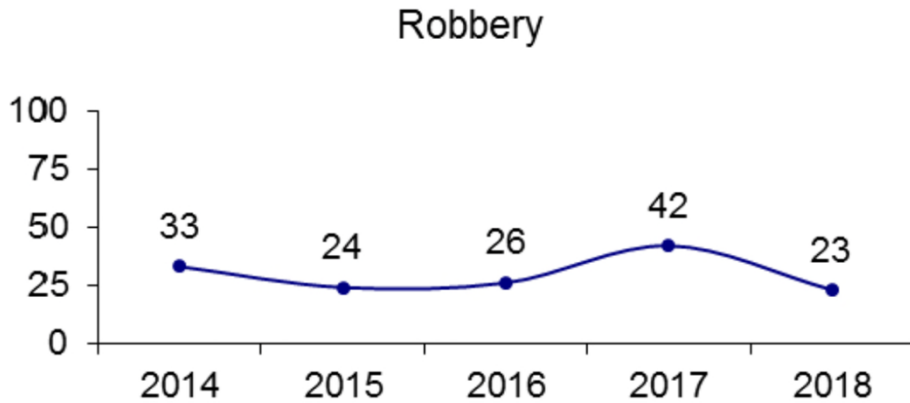


All Burglaries by Patrol District 2016-2018

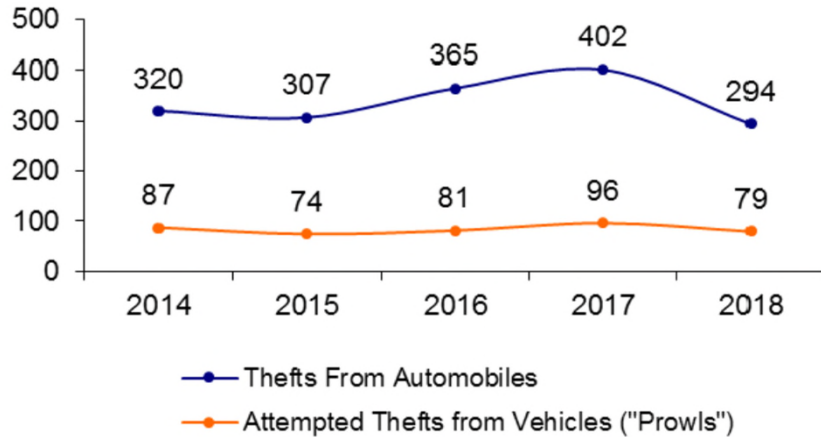

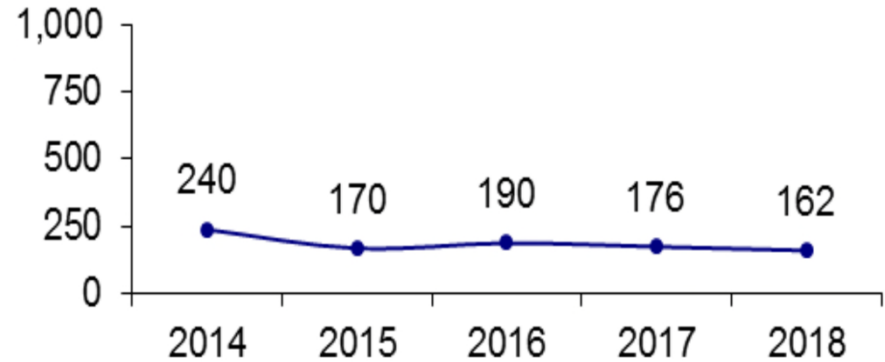
