Shoreline's CDBG Program

- Approximately \$320,831 in CDBG funds available yearly
- Interlocal with King County
- Allocated to regional projects, administration and local capital projects
 - Minor Home Repair Program (Sound Generations)
 - Housing Set Aside
- Requirement to hold a Public Hearing yearly and when reprogramming funds

Housing Set Aside

- Has been used in Shoreline housing projects
- Challenges of CDBG regulations difficult to use effectivity, especially when the CDBG funds are a small percentage of the total project
- No housing project is currently able to use the funds
- Timeliness issues
