I am a 75 year old who has lived in Shoreline the majority of my life. I have lived in the condominium complex situate on Linden Ave. and North 160th for almost 40 years. I have carefully reviewed the Shoreline Place website.

While I agree that re-development of the property is needed, I have significant concerns re: the impact on traffic on North 160th. This 4 lane street has a high amount of traffic from the college most of the day. That traffic increases during early morning and late afternoon, due to transit to / from work.

Whether driving or walking, accessing or crossing North 160th is a significant challenge. Access is especially difficult for pedestrians.

The added traffic from the development will increase the challenges to accessing / crossing North 160th. Reduction of the current four lanes of thru traffic on North 160th to two lanes will increase this challenge. I feel strongly that bike lanes and the middle turn lane will not alleviate this outcome.
