<p>Work Towards a Zero Waste Shoreline</p>	<p>To meet these criteria, proposals should address actions to reduce waste and conserve natural resources for present and future generations. Example projects include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Reduce solid waste and/or household hazardous waste generation b. Increase recycling, composting and reuse of resources c. Conserve energy d. Conserve water e. Educate the community about sustainability best practices
<p>Support Reduction of Greenhouse Gas Emissions</p>	<p>To meet these criteria, proposals should address actions that reduce greenhouse gas emissions or increase community resilience to climate change. Example projects include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Plant trees to increase shade and absorb carbon dioxide b. Install public bicycle racks or public electric vehicle charging stations c. Install renewable energy infrastructure (such as solar panels) in areas deemed for public use d. Educate the community about best practices and actions to address climate change
<p>Protect Our Natural Environment</p>	<p>To meet these criteria, proposals should address actions to protect and restore environmental quality and habitat. Example projects include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Prevent pollution, including water pollution b. Encourage proper disposal of hazardous waste c. Restore natural habitat d. Educate the community about personal stewardship of Shoreline’s environment
