Ordinance No. 865:

**Amending
the City of Shoreline's
Commute Trip Reduction Plan**



State Commute Trip Reduction Law

Shoreline is required to have a CTR Plan which aims at reducing single-occupant vehicle trips

- This affects 6 CTR sites (employers) in Shoreline.
- The City contracts with King County to help implement programs with all 6 sites.



Updates to the CTR Plan

The City is required to update its CTR Plan at least every four years

- This allows for the establishment of new 4-year targets and program strategies.
- Last update was for the 2015-2019 program cycle and an update is now due.



CTR Board Exemption

Local jurisdictions are exempted from update requirements for the 2019-2023 cycle.

- Ordinance No. 865 utilizes State Board exemption by extending the current plan through 2023.
- Staff will update CTR Plan in concurrence with Transportation Master Plan Update (beginning in 2020)



Public Hearing on Ordinance No. 865

- The purpose of this public hearing is to receive comments on proposed Ordinance No. 865 which amends the City of Shoreline current CTR Plan to cover the 2019-2023 planning period.



Adoption of Ordinance No. 865

Council is scheduled to adopt proposed Ordinance No. 865 amending the City's CTR Plan on September 30, 2019.
