- Limit trips for groceries, gas, and other essentials
- If you must go out, stay at least six feet away from others at all times.

- Development permits currently not accepted except those that can be completed online.
- All meetings and events have been cancelled at least through the end of April.

- Gatherings, games, group picnics, etc. are prohibited.
- Parks, trails, and natural areas will remain open only if social distance can be maintained.
