# Recreation and Gathering:

- Phase 1:
  - Limited allowances for fishing, golf, boating
- Phase 2:
  - Outdoor recreation and gatherings of fewer than 5 people outside your household
- Phase 3:
  - Outdoor recreation, sports and gatherings up to 50 people
- Phase 4:
  - Free to play and to gather, still maintain physical distancing
- All Phases:
  - Physical distancing and limited travel within proximity of your home

#### Ideas for New Events

- Micro-neighborhood concerts
- Neighborhood color identity celebration day to wear color of your neighborhood
- On-line video concerts
- Sidewalk/street chalk art
- Shared art panels in neighborhoods or parks
- Painted rocks scavenger hunt and photo competition
- Virtual Scavenger hunt
- Can Castle event build in front of house, pick-up food for food bank
- Document your COVID-19 experience through art



# Canceled Summer Camps

- 10 weeks of camps starting June 22
- 162 scheduled camps
- 2,604 slots enrolled; 775 unique registrants
- 391 on wait lists



### New Plan for Summer Camps

- Groups of 8 campers with 2 staff
- Each camp group assigned the same space for the duration of the camp
- Each group is assigned a restroom
- Group activities maintain social distancing
- The number of camper groups will depend on space availability
- Staggered camp start times
- Custodian on-site each day to spot clean high touch areas
