





Property owner meetings

- Recent and ongoing meetings:
 - Lake Forest Park: 66 letters sent, 43 meetings scheduled (65% response rate)
 - **Kenmore:** 6 letters sent, 3 meetings scheduled (50% response rate)
 - **Seattle:** 9 letters sent, 4 meetings scheduled (44% response rate)
 - **Shoreline:** 21 letters sent, 6 meetings scheduled (28% response rate)
 - Some property owners are deferring until in-person meetings are possible

Property Owner meetings

- Follow-up efforts:
 - Sent follow-up letters and emails to those who have not responded
 - Calling property owners in Lake Forest Park and Kenmore to schedule meetings, will also do so in Shoreline and Seattle
- Upcoming meetings:
 - Bothell tentatively starting this Summer
