Changes were made in the past year to the process for reserving city parks and picnic shelters. What had been a relatively straight-forward process became bulky and difficult. The online reservation website became more complicated and confusing to use, requiring numerous "clicks" and transfers between pages. The online calendar is basically unreadable. Reservation times allowed were changed to just two periods during a day. Reservation paperwork now requires what are basically duplicate forms to be filled out instead of one form, a "Neighborhood Event Permit Application" and a "Park & Open Space Non-exclusive Event Permit Application."

Hopefully PRCS staff can revamp this process and return it to a simpler, more user-friendly system.
