- 1 am writing to express support for a permanent family homeless shelter in Shoreline. The pandemic and pending eviction crisis on top of am ongoing housing and homelessness crisis in Seattle metro makes this shelter necessary as the needs are dire. Data shows that while people cite many reasons for why they became homeless, the biggest correlation with cities with higher homelessness is market inelasticity created by topography (Portland, Seattle, San Francisco water, hills, etc.) and rigid zoning (Seattle is zoned 70% for single family housing). As the cities work to overcome these long-term barriers, we need more emergency safety nets especially with Covid and safety issues primarily hitting communities of color here already at risk.
