I am a dog and kid mom living in the Ballinger neighborhood. I have been a dog person for most of my life and our dog has been a part of our family for 7 years. She is a rescue dog and a large part of what helped us to address her traumatic anxiety was socialization through visits to dog parks. She loves dog parks often acts like a kid at Disneyland when we pull up to one.

I wholeheartedly support maintaining at least 2.5 dog parks in Shoreline (Shoreview, Richmond Beach, Eastside/Insert possible park name here). Having looked up where the proposed new site is, my concern is that it's next to the freeway and thus too loud for dogs. Additionally, James Keough Park is on the west side of the freeway and this would leave those of us on the east side of I-5 with no dog park within city limits.

I want to propose consideration of the cricket field on 200th between 25th Ave NE and 30th Ave NE. This site is away from the freeway, has paved parking already, and is already used for off leash dog activities. It would place a dog park in northern Shoreline, maintain off leash presence on the east side if I-5, and be accessible to those in Lake Forest Park as well, which has no off leash areas. The area is largely residential and I would personally love to be able to walk to a park and meet my neighbors and their furry family members.
