This time to convert a nursing home facility into a low barrier homeless shelter on 165th and Aurora to be opened as early as December. Low barrier meaning no background checks and would allow anyone on drugs or with warrants. This is very close to a lot of residences, day cares, rec center and high school. A lot of the neighbors in the vicinity are concerned about safety as the city has not made any efforts towards community outreach and haven't provided any details. This was discussed on the council meeting on Monday. No details have been released aside from the fact that it will be a low barrier facility owned by King County with the city having no control.
