Hello,

I'm writing you to express my strong opinion that there not be a low-barrier shelter in Shoreline. This shelter will draw homeless people from across northern Seattle and drop them into Shoreline. My in-laws just moved to the Meridian Park neighborhood, just a few blocks from the proposed shelter site. My family, including 2 and 3 year olds, live in the Parkwood neighborhood. This shelter makes me less comfortable leaving my children at my in-laws because when they go out on outings they will certainly have a higher likelihood of being exposed to undesirable behavior stemming from the shelter. My in-laws bought their house less than a year ago, and now they are questioning whether that was the right decision.

It's not fair to the existing Shoreline residents, including families with small children, to make Shoreline a destination for homelessness.

I've donated to the legal fund for the next-door daycare center that is considering bringing a lawsuit against the city of Shoreline.
