# Background

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- Ordinance No. 906 Adopted Oct. 26
  - Established Enhanced Shelter use in R-48 Zone
  - Established criteria Enhanced Shelters must comply with, including development of an ILA
- Ordinance No. 913 Amending Ordinance No. 906 Adopted Nov. 16
  - Changed ILA to three-party MOA
  - Amended introductory language and removed requirement for payment for excess 911 calls

# MOA Development

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- Index Criteria directs City to enter into an MOA with King County and Lake City Partners
- Staff worked to negotiate MOA with both organizations

# MOA Provisions

- The final MOA addresses each of the items on the Council's suggested list
- MOA also includes insurance and indemnification provisions
- Term of the agreement is through June 2023
- Staff recommends that Council authorize the City Manager to sign the MOA
