# This Week in Shoreline January 25, 2021

Highlights from the past weeks and previews of coming events



### **Healthy Washington Plan – Phase 1:**

To move to Phase 2, regions must meet 4 criteria. As of January 22, our region has not yet met this criteria:

- 10% decrease in two-week rate of new COVID cases
  X PUGET SOUND REGION: +23%
- 10% decrease in two-week rate of new COVID hospital admissions
  X PUGET SOUND REGION: -9%
- ICU occupancy of less than 90% (both COVID and non-COVID cases)
  PUGET SOUND REGION: 84%
- COVID-19 test positivity rate of less than 10%.
  - ✓ PUGET SOUND REGION: 9%

#### Phase 1 restrictions and allowances:

- Indoor gatherings are prohibited
- Outdoor gatherings limited to 10 people from two households
- Restaurants and bars
  - Closed for indoor service
  - Restricted outdoor dining, to-go service and delivery allowed
- Retail, grocery stores & personal services 25% occupancy limit
- Entertainment, fitness facilities and gyms extremely limited.
- Outdoor sports limited to intra-team practice and all, including athletes, must wear face coverings
- Indoor spiritual and religious services must limit capacity.
- Non-essential travel to other states or counties should be avoided.


### **King County Positive COVID-19 Case Trends**

### Take prevention measures:

- All people 50 years or older in multigenerational households (home where individuals from 2 or more generations reside such as an elder and a grandchild)
- · High-risk critical workers 50 years or older who work in certain congregate settings: Agriculture: food processing; grocery stores: K-12 (educators & staff); childcare; corrections; prisons, jails or detention centers; public transit; fire; law enforcement

TIER 2

· People 16 years or older with 2 or more co-morbidities or underlying conditions

TIER 3

 High-risk critical workers under 50 years who work in certain congregate settings (as noted in B2)

TIER 4

- People, staff, and volunteers in congregate living settings: Correctional facilities; group homes for people with disabilities: people experiencing homelessness that live in or access services in congregate settings
- Information on who is eligible for Phases 2, 3 & 4 coming soon.
