CDBG

- Shoreline receives CDBG funds on an annual basis
- Public Hearing and Action taken each fall
- Approximately 48% is available for local projects



- CDBG Regulation changes
 - No limit on use for Human Services
 - 5-day public comment period
 - Must be used in response to COVID



- \$5 Billion for CDBG (CDBG-CV)
 - Round 1, \$2 Billion through regular formula
 - Shoreline Council approved 5/18/2020
 - Round 2, \$1 Billion for state/insular areas
 - Round 3, \$2 Billion allocated through a new formal – for review/discussion today

- Request for proposals, with focused areas
 - Food assistance
 - Rent assistance
 - Behavioral health
 - Services for students affected by school closure
- Received 5 applications from 4 agencies, totaling \$606,179

CDBG-CV Round 3 Recommendation

- Total of \$322,398 in CDBG funds available
- Allocation
 - \$6,448 KC administrative costs (may vary)
 - \$137,771 Hopelink Rent Assistance
 - \$78,179 CHS Behavioral Health
- \$100,000 LCP Rent Assistance

CDBG-CV Round 3 Recommendation

- King County has not set their administrative percentage
- If changes are necessary:
 - If more program funds are available, increase will go to Hopelink
 - If program reductions are necessary, first \$5,000 would be taken from Hopelink and second \$5,000 from Lake City Partners
