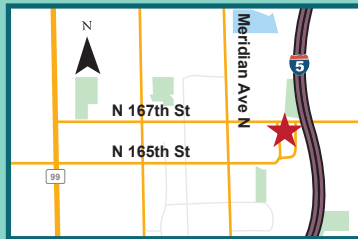

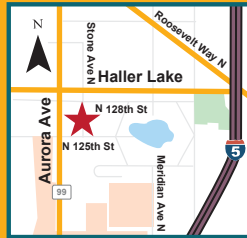


Hazardous Waste Drop Off Location

Recology offers a free residential **Special Item Recycling** program for items that are not accepted inside your curbside recycling container and are hard to properly dispose of, including:

- Fluorescent Tubes and Bulbs
- Styrofoam
- Small Appliances and Electronics
- Propane Canisters (small, camping-style)
- Motor and Cooking Oil
- Clothing and Textiles
- Batteries

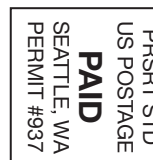


Call (206) 763-4444 to schedule a special item pick up from Recology and for preparation instructions. Service must be requested by the bill payer on record.

Appliances


(small, less than 2x2x2 ft)

Donate working appliances at local thrift stores

Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444 (fees apply for large appliances)

Drop off:

- The Recology Store Shoreline (less than 60 lbs.)
- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station (all sizes, fees apply for any appliances with refrigerants)



Batteries

Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444

Drop off:


- Bartell Drugs, Photo Center: 18420 Aurora Ave N
- City Hall Lobby: 17500 Midvale Avenue N
- North City Water District Office: 1519 NE 177th St
- Walgreens, Photo Center: 17524 Aurora Ave N
- 14510 Aurora Ave N
- The Recology Store Shoreline: Tape ends with clear packing tape. Limit ¼ gallon per drop-off.



Bicycles & Bicycle Parts

Drop off:

- The Recology Store Shoreline
- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station



Building Materials

Drop off usable materials at building supply salvage businesses (call for accepted materials):

- SecondUse: 3223 6th Ave S, Seattle (206) 763-6929
- Earthwise Architectural Salvage: 3447 4th Ave S, Seattle (206) 905-4294

Drop off clean wood and pallets (no paint or stain):

- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station (fees apply)




Bulky Items: Furniture & Large Appliances

Donate items in good condition at local thrift stores

Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444 (fees apply)

Drop off:

- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station (fees apply for some items)




Clothing, Shoes & Textiles

Donate items in good condition at local thrift stores

Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444

Drop off clean, dry items, including torn or worn items:

- The Recology Shoreline Store
- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station

Electronics

Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444 (small electronics only)

Drop off:

- The Recology Store Shoreline: small electronics 2x2x2 ft or smaller and less than 60 lbs.; TVs up to 40 inches
- Local thrift stores
- The Home Depot stores (cell phones only)
- Visit ecyclewashington.org and Call2recycle.org for more locations.




Fluorescent Light Bulbs

Unbroken fluorescent tubes and compact fluorescent (CFL) bulbs accepted. Limit 10 bulbs or tubes per drop-off.

Needles & Medicine

Do not flush down the toilet or put in the garbage.

Drop off needles placed in a sturdy, sealed plastic container: Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station

Drop off over-the-counter and prescription medications: QFC Pharmacy, Shoreline Police Department, or International Community Health Services: 16549 Aurora Ave N

Paint

Drop off leftover latex paint in the original can at the Recology Store Shoreline (fees apply)

Dispose of empty and dry latex paint cans in the garbage (use pet litter or air dry)

Drop off oil-based paint, thinners and stains: North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility



Plastic Bags & Wrap

Drop off:

- Local grocery stores. Find locations at plasticfilmrecycling.org.
- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station: accepts clean, dry and empty plastic bags, film and wrap (bubble wrap, plastic grocery bags, and plastic wrap from beverage cases, toilet paper, and paper towels).



Propane Tanks & Canisters


Pick up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444 (small canisters only, must be completely empty)

Drop off small, camping style canisters:

- The Recology Store Shoreline (small canisters only, must be completely empty)

Drop off large tanks:

- North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility

Scrap Metal

Drop off:

- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station: accepts aluminum, brass, copper, iron and steel, up to 8 feet long and up to 200 pounds.




Styrofoam® Blocks & Peanuts

Pick Up: schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444

Drop off:

- The Recology Store Shoreline: accepts packing peanuts, rigid foam blocks, and clean foam takeout food containers. Must be clean, dry and free of tape. Limit 32 gallons per drop off.
- Shoreline Recycling & Transfer Station: accepts rigid blocks and coolers only. No packing peanuts.




Used Oil

Pick up—Motor & Cooking Oil: Schedule with Recology at (206) 763-4444. Separate cooking and motor oil in leak-free, clear plastic jugs with screw top lid. Label with name and address and place on the ground next to recycling cart (limit 3 gallons per collection).

Drop off—Motor Oil:

- O'Reilly Auto Parts—Call ahead: (206) 533-0179
- North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Collection Facility



Household Hazardous Waste

Products marked "CAUTION," "WARNING," "DANGER," or "POISON" require hazardous materials disposal. Shoreline residents and businesses can take hazardous waste to the North Seattle Household Hazardous Waste Facility at no cost.
