

Shoreline Positive COVID-19Case Trends



Healthy Washington Phase 3:

- Indoor gatherings: Maximum 10 people from outside your household
- Outdoor gatherings: Maximum 50 people
- All indoor spaces can allow 50% capacity, including restaurants, gyms, fitness centers, and movie theaters.
- In-person spectators at sporting events with stationary seating allowed at 25% capacity.
- Counties will be evaluated for progress every three weeks.


Continue prevention measures:
