Thank you for considering the placement of a parks bond measure on the upcoming November ballot. Despite the April ballot falling just shy of the validation requirement, I believe the 72% "yes" vote is indicative of the broad community support for this initiative. Through the past year and a half of the pandemic, Shoreline residents have become increasingly aware of the value of our public spaces and we need to invest in them more.
